# Entry Guidelines

## PreK- Grade 3: Posters

Children in this category will have the choice to submit **one** of the following entries:

### Entry Options

- Posters either a) hand-drawn or b) computer-made. Posters should also have a minimum of **3 sentences** attached answering the three key questions.
- Creative Writing Piece (poem, short story, paragraph), answering the three key questions.
- Creative Art Piece (lego, play-doh, etc.) with a minimum of 3 sentences attached answering the three key questions.
- A video (maximum of 2 minutes in length) of the child answering the three key questions.

*If you could design your dream school, what would it look like?*

*What would you be learning there?*

*What would it feel like to be at your dream school?*
